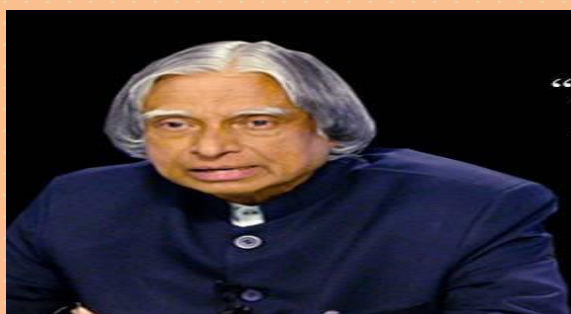

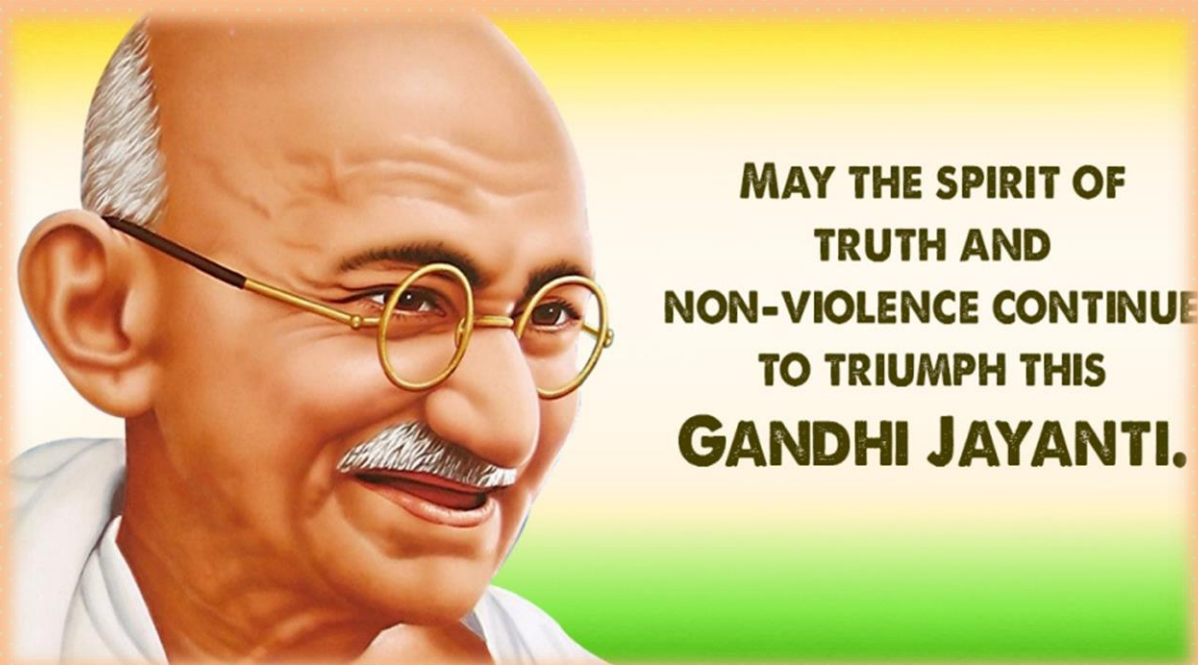

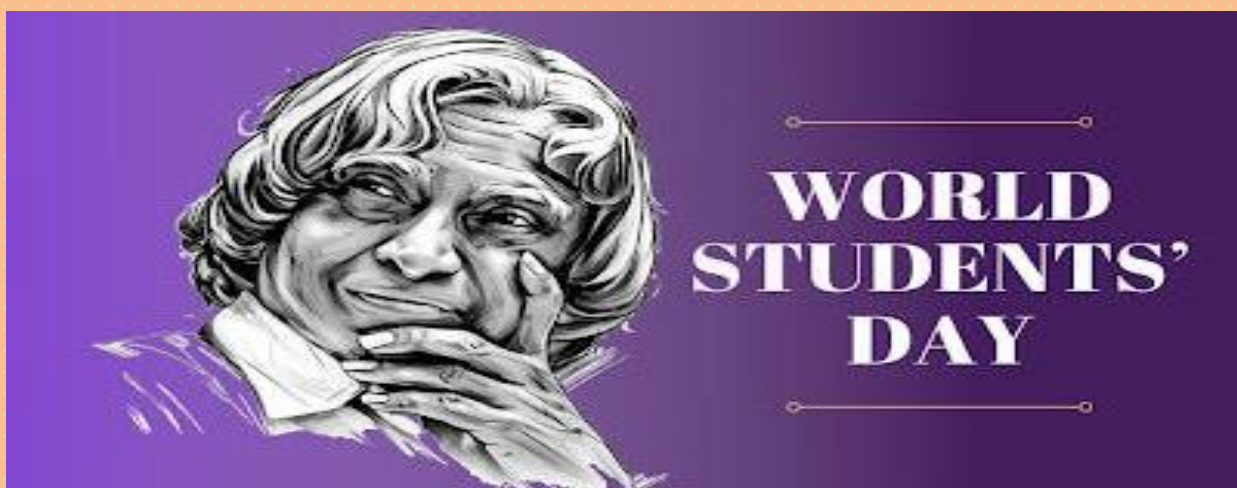




## INTERNSHIP DRIVE

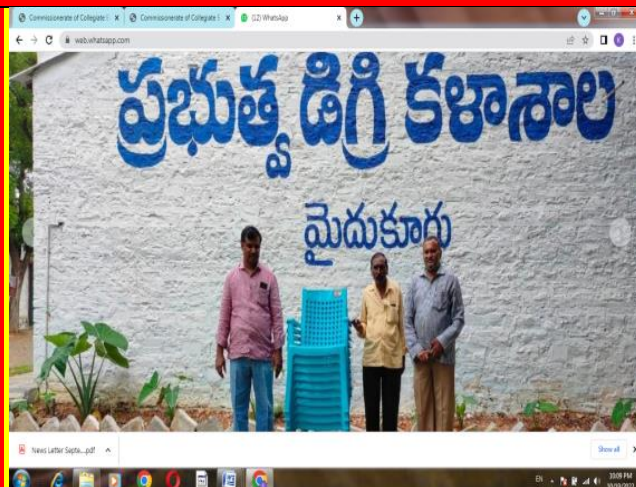


## Mega Job Drive and Catalysing Education 4.0
